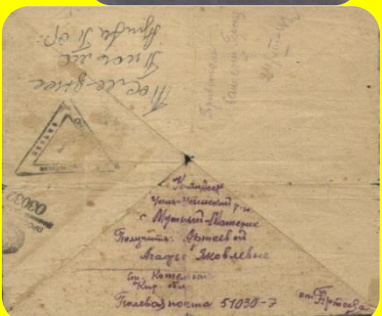

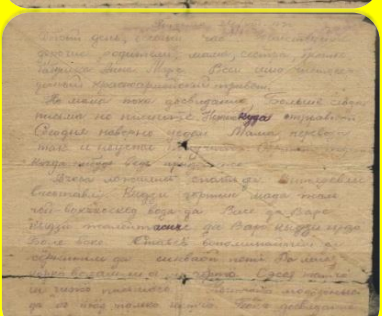


I remember! I am proud!

On June 22, 1941, fascist Germany attacked the Soviet Union. On the same day the Soviet people rose up for a patriotic war and took an active part in the fighting against the enemy. They fought heroically and showed the greatest heroism, courage on the battlefields. Millions of them gave their lives for their Motherland. The war finished in May 9 in 1945. It was a great and memorable day. 196 men from the village of Mytny Matherik went to the war to defend their Motherland from the fascist aggressors. 82 soldiers came back home.



My great-grandfather Arteev Prokopiya Philippovich was drafted into the army in January 1943 and sent to the Kirovsky region to become a junior leader. After that he was sent to the Karelsky front. He went missing in August 1943. My great-grandfather was born in the village of Mytny Matherik in 1925. In our family album there is only one photo of him. He wrote 3 letters from the front to his old parents and in every letter he was interested in the village life. He asked how inhabitants worked on the collective farm: in the fields, in the haymaking, in the forest. Inhabitants labored for the army in the rear, despite the hardest conditions and hunger.



In my village there is an obelisk to the fallen soldiers which is situated on the highest hill. Our duty is to remember and not to forget about the heroic deed of our ancestors in the front and in the rear. Thanks to our great-grandfathers we have a peaceful sky over our heads and we live in a free country. Our ancestors played a great role in the Victory. We remember them and we are very proud of them. We must always say together: «NO WAR!»
